





#### Race and Ethnicity of Manitowoc County (2020)






# Manitowoc County Top Industries by Number of Employees (2019)




#### Household Income in the Past 12 Months (2020)









Race and Ethnicity of Online Survey Respondents (2022)





Annual Household Income Before Taxes of Online Survey Respondents (2022)





Childcare costs for a household with 2 children as a percent of median household income (\$58,464)









# Reading Scores of 3rd Graders (2018)






Percent of high school students who experienced hunger due to lack of food at home (past 30 days)








Child Poverty Rates (2015-2020)







Percent of high school students that engaged in alcohol or substance use in the past 30 days




"Always/Nearly Always Feeling Sad, Blue, or Depressed" (2010-2022)




Percent of adult respondents who reported "Always/Nearly Always Felt Sad, Blue, or Depressed in Past Month"

# Mental Health Conditions of Children in Manitowoc County (2022)





Mental Health Conditions of Students in Manitowoc County (2019)














Number of deaths among residents under age 75 per 100,000 population (age-adjusted)



# Number of Suicide Deaths in Manitowoc County (2016-2021)




